Dear Friends and Supporters,

Happy Tamil New Year!

As we step into a new financial year, we do so with renewed energy and purpose. Every new beginning brings hope, fresh challenges, innovative solutions, and a deep reminder that we are here for a meaningful reason. Before we move ahead, we would like to pause and reflect on the year gone by.

It has truly been a year of steady progress. Our free physiotherapy centre continued to grow, enabling us to reach 51 children through 1536 physiotherapy sessions, compared to 750 sessions to 33 children last year. Our flagship initiative of providing orthopaedic aids also maintained strong momentum, with 758 aids delivered to 537 children.

Beyond healthcare, we expanded our community initiatives. A saree pre-pleating training program was conducted to help women build an additional source of income. Our Children's Carnival, as always, brought immense joy and participation from the community. We also celebrated special occasions such as Mother's Day, Children's Day, and Christmas, creating moments of inclusion and happiness.

Financially, it was a challenging year for much of the time. However, our fundraising campaign launched in February successfully reached its goal, offering us much-needed relief and stability.

On the human resources front, we grew from a team of five to six dedicated members, strengthening our ability to serve more effectively.

One of our key operational improvements this year has been reducing the delivery time for orthopaedic aids—from an average of 15 days to just 4 days. This was made possible through consistent engagement with our vendors and greater awareness within the community about the urgency of timely intervention.

Above all, the most meaningful impact lies in the transformation we witnessed in the children we serve. For one child, simply being able to stand was a dream fulfilled. For another, finding a sense of belonging brought about a remarkable change in behaviour. These moments define our purpose and inspire us to continue moving forward.

While our primary focus has always been children, we also extend support to adults in need. During the year, we provided a Neo Bolt wheelchair to an individual with a spinal cord injury in Assam, enabling greater mobility, independence thereby increasing his earning capacity.

We have put together a short video of our last year's activities.

None of this would have been possible without your unwavering support. We remain deeply grateful to each one of you—our donors and well-wishers.

We look forward to continuing this journey together in the year ahead.
