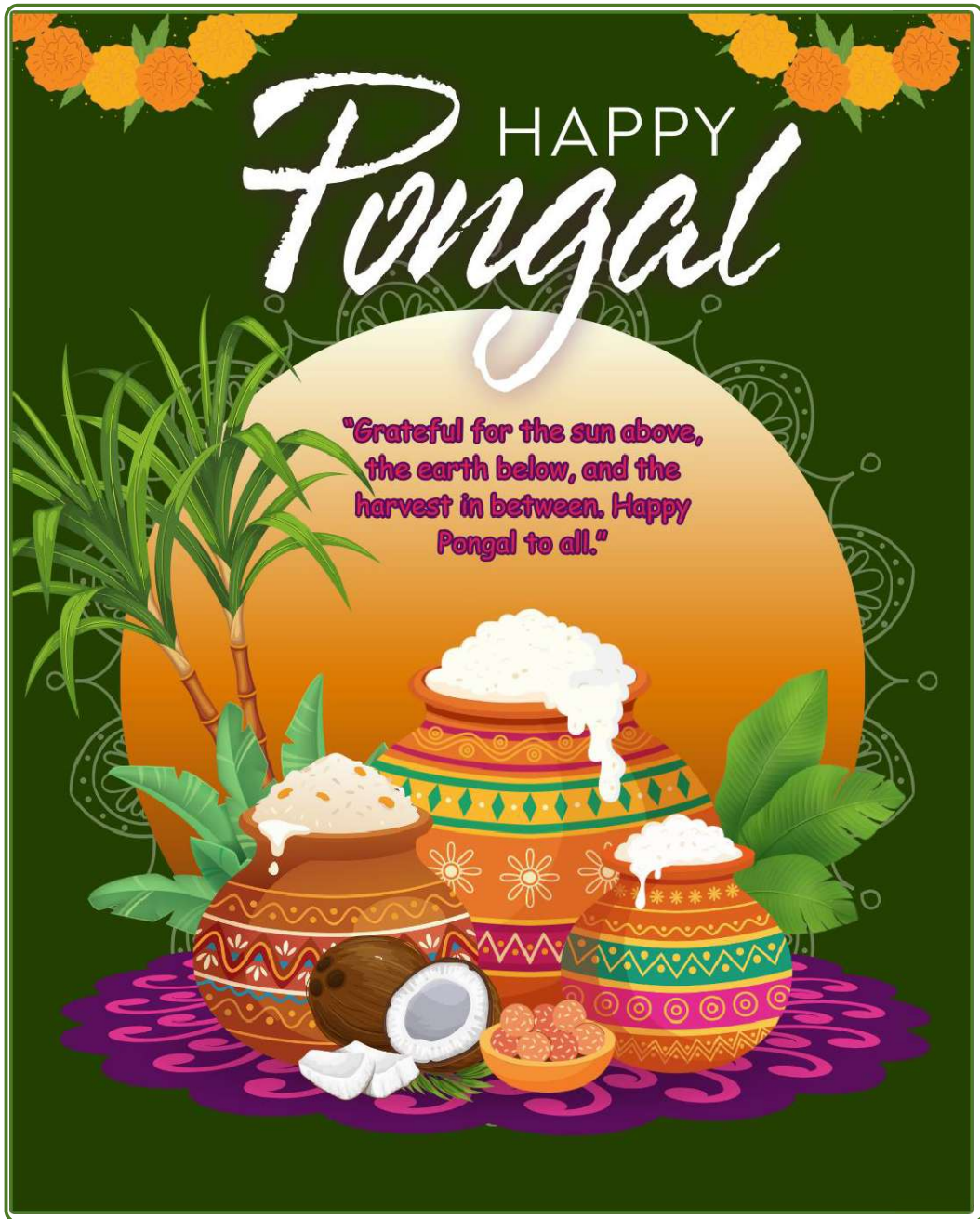

Looking back at 2025, we are happy to share that it has truly been a year of growth. At our Baby Cure Centre, we supported 47 children with 1,200 physiotherapy sessions, compared to 30 children with 625 sessions in 2024. We also provided 764 orthopaedic aids to 547 children, as against 737 aids to 528 children in 2024. These numbers reflect not just progress, but the collective impact of your continued support.

Our annual event, “The Children’s Carnival,” is just around the corner. We request you to kindly save the date — 31st January 2026 — and join us in celebrating with our children.

Let us continue to move forward together — keeping the spirit alive, and keeping our mission growing in 2026.

We have lost not just a donor, but a dear friend and a true champion of our cause — Mr. R. S. Jagannathan.

He often said, *“I am not rich, but I follow one principle: for every rupee I earn, five paise must go to charity.”* He lived by this principle till his very last day.

From 2010 onwards, he supported us through regular monthly contributions till his retirement. Later when he took up re-employment, he doubled his contribution. Over the last ten months, while bravely battling cancer, he never stopped giving. His final donation reached us in November; he left us in December.
